About Our Clinic



A clinic for the diagnosis and treatment of young children with speech, language and literacy challenges . . . Supported by the Western Montana Scottish Rite Foundation in partnership with The University of Montana

The University of Montana RiteCare Speech, Language and Hearing Clinic, originally established in 1998, is housed at the Curry Health Center on The University of Montana campus. The clinic is staffed by students supervised by licensed speech-language pathologists to provide diagnostic and therapeutic treatment of speech, language and literacy difficulties.



The RiteCare Clinic is open to the public, offering services to young children with speech, language, and literacy difficulties. Clinic services are provided

based on need and without regard to ethnicity, gender, culture, or religious beliefs.

Masonic affiliation is not required.

Services Provided

Diagnosis

Prior to treatment, the child is evaluated and observed to determine communication skills and abilities. After the assessment process has been completed, a conference is scheduled to discuss the results and recommendations with the child's family.

Treatment

Following the diagnostic evaluation, the child may be enrolled for therapy. The therapy sessions meet the child's individual needs and include training and support for families to work with their child at home.



Eligibility

Infants, toddlers and young children who exhibit speech, language, and literacy delays.

Referral Procedure

The clinic primarily serves children from western Montana.

Families must provide transportation.
